This dynamic space, complete with the full range of Mode 3 areas, is the perfect area for students to explore and immerse themselves in learning.

After a very successful outcome of the Canterbury senior space, Civic Australia was approached to design the new Junior Space, also known as their 'Discovery Centre'. The school is a beautiful campus that overlooks the Logan River. It encompasses state-of-the-art facilities and a student population which now exceeds 1,400.

DE LA SALLE COLLEGE


De La Salle College, Revesby Heights is a systemic, Roman Catholic day school for boys located in Revesby Heights, in the south-west of Sydney, New South Wales, Australia. The school was founded as a school of the De La Salle brothers in 1960.

The school's staff area, a library and 3 classrooms needed refurbishing. The 3 classrooms had to encompass flexible furniture so it could open and convert to an assembly area when required. Tim Logue, principal, worked closely with Ben Rowland (Project Consultant) & Rebecca Camilleri (Interior Designer) to finalise the furniture, quantities and finishes


